

# Cookie Policy

Our website, mobile apps, social media and other online services may use “cookies” as well as data on browsing. Cookies are unique identifiers – generally small text strings or pieces of code – which are usually stored on your device or in your browser and which send information of particular kinds back to their originator.

Cookies and similar techniques are used to enhance the user’s experience of browsing the website; they also make it possible to know how many unique visitors come to the website, how often they return and how they use the site, so that its contents can be updated at suitable intervals, and in order to improve browsing, send advertising-relevant information, and reinforce website security.

Most browsers (Internet Explorer, Firefox, etc.) are configured to accept cookies, but nearly all offer ways of checking on them and even disabling them through the browser settings. You should bear in mind, though, that if you disable navigation cookies or functional cookies this could stop the website working properly and/or limit the service we provide.

This website in fact gathers no personal details of users: it does not use cookies to send personal information, nor indeed any “persistent” cookies, profiling cookies, or user tracking systems.

In our website we use the following kinds of cookie:

## **NAVIGATION COOKIES**

As soon as the website is accessed these cookies enable it to function properly and ensure that browsing and use of the website proceed as they should and that you, the user, can display its contents on your device. Whenever registration is necessary, navigation cookies will let the website recognize users and admit them to their restricted areas and the services available there. Navigation cookies are described as “technical”: they are needed for the website to work.

## **FUNCTIONAL COOKIES**

Functional cookies are used for service provision or to restore settings for the purpose of improving the visit and the user’s experience on the website. These cookies can also be used to provide functions requested by the user – like displaying a video, for instance. The details they gather are not used to track your browsing or your activities. Functional cookies are not essential for the website to work, but they do improve its quality and the user experience.

## **ANALYTIC COOKIES**

These cookies are used in carrying out statistical analyses of the way users browse our website. The results of those analyses are handled in entirely anonymous form, and for statistical purposes only; they are not used at all unless the service provider uses cookies in connection with the browser or other device used for browsing the website.

## **SOCIAL NETWORK COOKIES**

These cookies are needed to enable your social media account to interact with our website. They enable you, for instance, to ‘like’ something and/or share it with people you are friends with on social media.

How third parties use the data they gather using social network plug-ins is entirely a matter for those third parties. Social network cookies are not necessary for browsing our website.
